Works independently on general property maintenance (painting, cleaning, sorting, etc.), customer notifications, 1-inch and smaller meter changeouts, and other work not requiring continuing direction or supervision. Performs other duties as assigned or as directed by supervisors.

Skills, knowledge and physical requirements include, but are not limited to:

- Hand tools, power tools, compaction and other equipment related to water distribution system maintenance may be used.
- May operate a company vehicle.
- Must be physically able to perform job duties that may require walking, bending, kneeling, digging and lifting items of at least seventy-five (75) pounds in weight.
- Must be able to work outside in all types of weather.
