With the **Niagara Conservation Showerhead**, you will save 40% flow and the ability to change to 3 unique settings.



When installing the low-flow showerhead, wrap plumber's tape twice around the seal of the threaded connection to prevent small drips from fixtures.



Niagara **Faucet Aerators** use only 1 gallon per minute, cutting the water usage at the sink in half.



The **Toilet Tank Bank** reduces the amount of water available or flushes by occupying available space for water within your toilet tank. This product saves you about 0.8 gallons per flush.



Drop **leak detection tablets** in your toilet tank and see if the water in your toilet bowl turns blue. If the water turns blue, you have a leak!



The most common cause of a leaky toilet is a worn toilet flapper. This high-quality Niagara **toilet flapper** is a great upgrade for old or broken flappers.

Fixing leaks and making water efficiency upgrades make a difference.





Desert plants get watered best with drip irrigation. The 2-gallon-perhour pressure compensating drip emitters provide a consistent, regulated flow of water to plants close to the ground to reduce evaporation. The result is more even and efficient watering of your plants.



Find where you will need a new irrigation line to run through and jab a hole in your main irrigation line with a **drip punch tool**.



When a plant dies, there is no need to continue watering where the plant used to be. A two-sided **goof plug** is used for plugging small leaks on drip irrigation lines or to close the end of spaghetti tubing.
